Personal data will not be transferred to EU Members States nor to Third countries that are not part of the EU.
- **Data storage duration:** data will be kept until the end of the state of emergency.
- **User rights:** users have a right to ask the Data Controller: to access their personal data and rectify or cancel them; to limit or refuse processing; and to transfer data.
